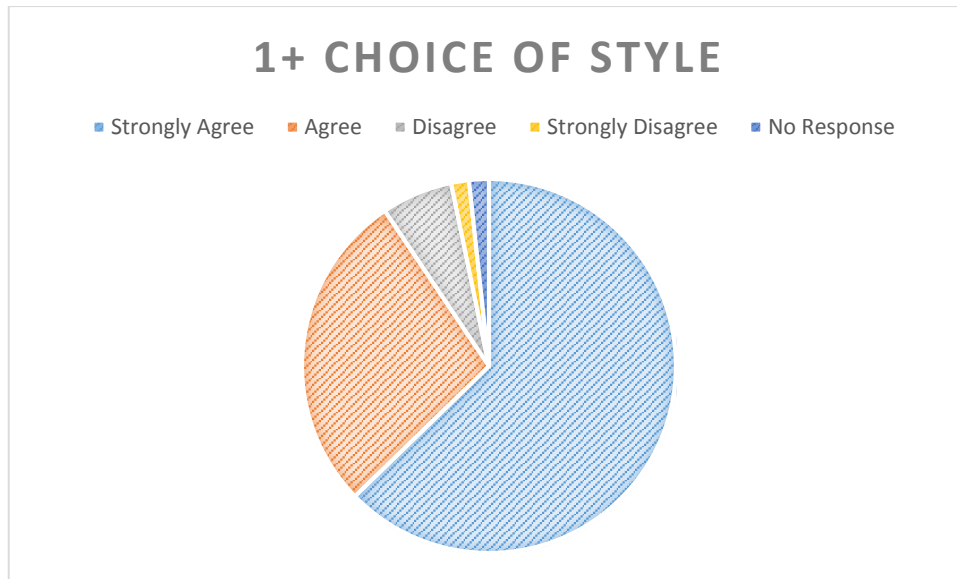

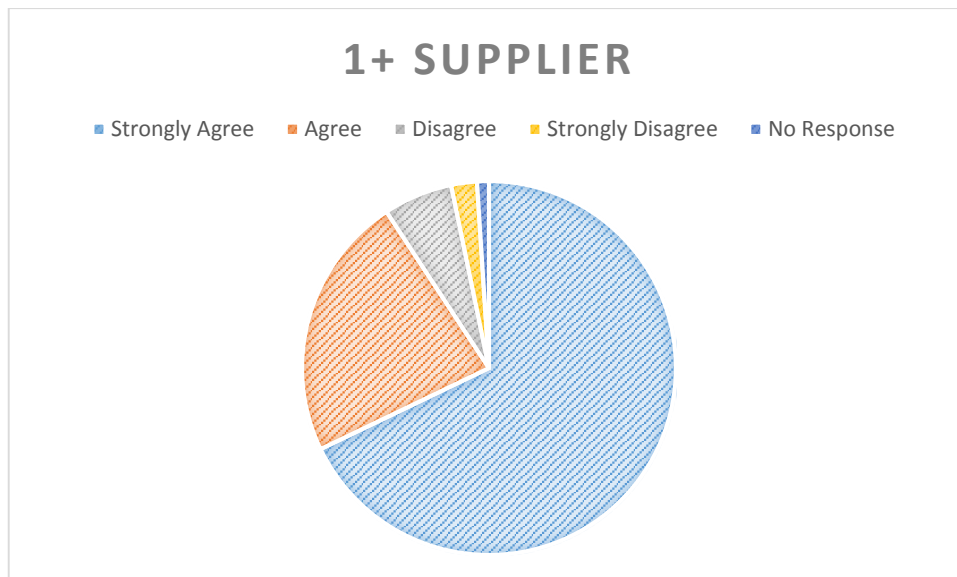
585 equates to 73% of Springwell Community College parent/carers.

1. There should be a choice of more than one style of trousers



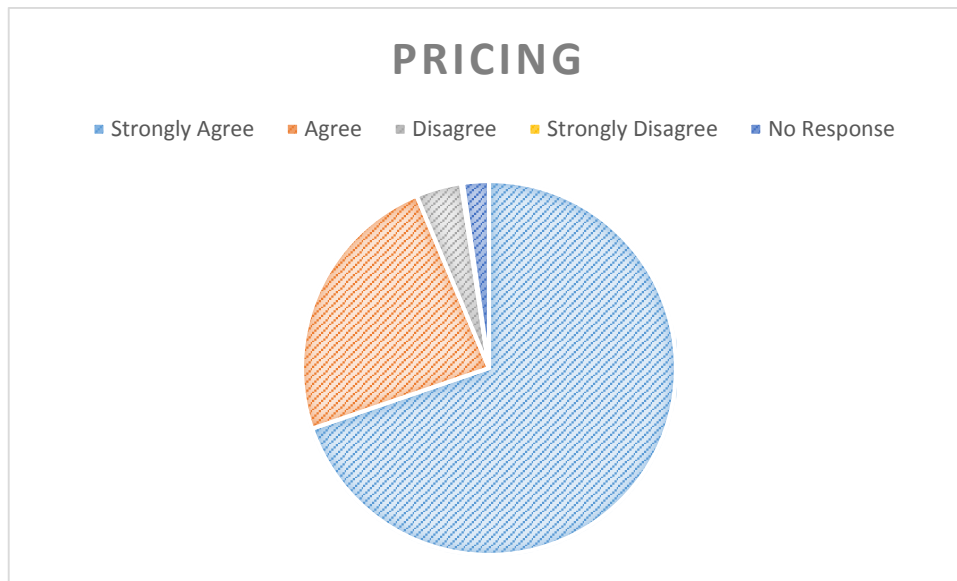
98% of parents/carers strongly agreed or agreed that there should more than one style of trouser available.

2. There should be more than one supplier of uniform



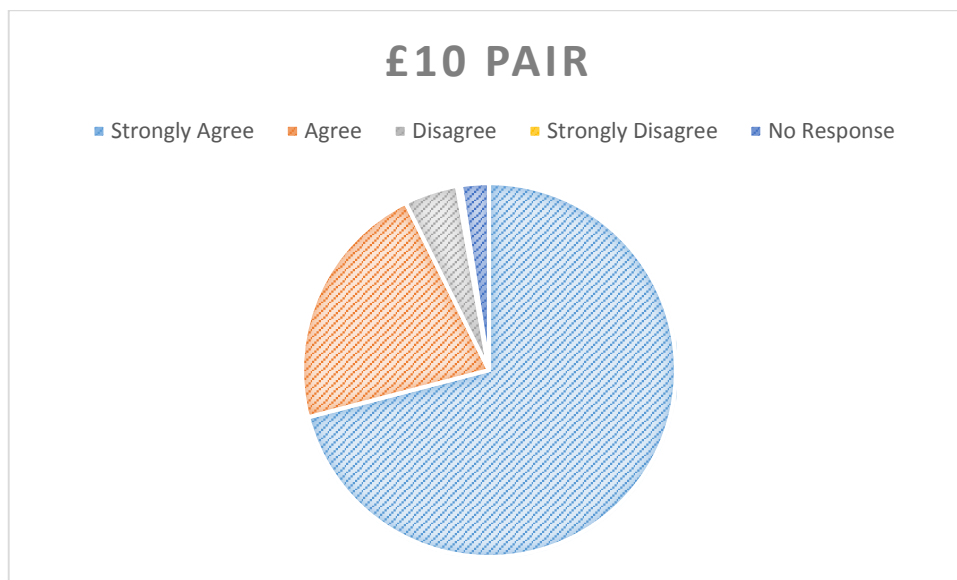
91% of parents/carers strongly agreed or agreed that there should be a more than on supplier of uniform.

3. There should be more choice in terms of pricing



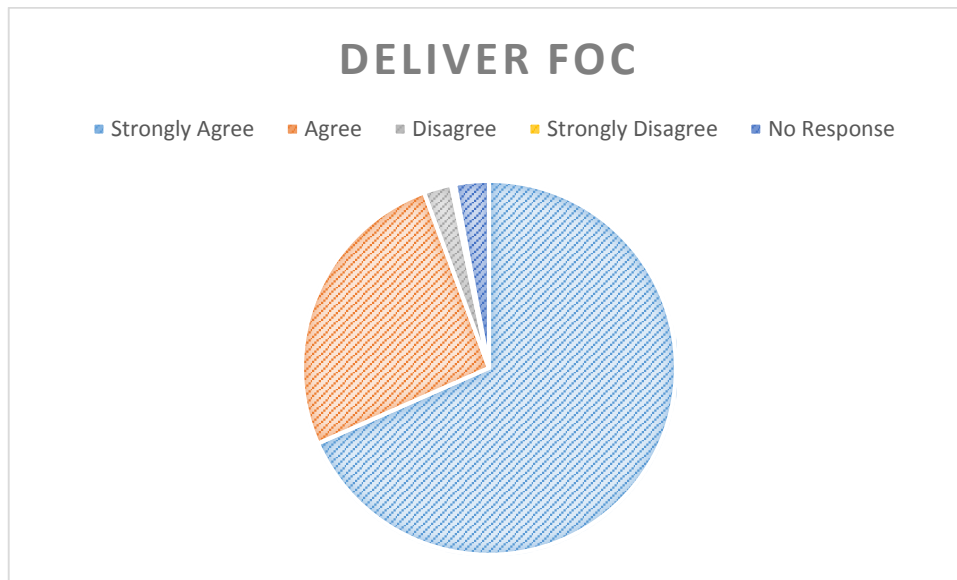
94% of parents/carers strongly agreed or agreed that there should be more choice in terms of pricing of uniform.

4. There should be at least one option of trousers priced at £10 or less, regardless of size



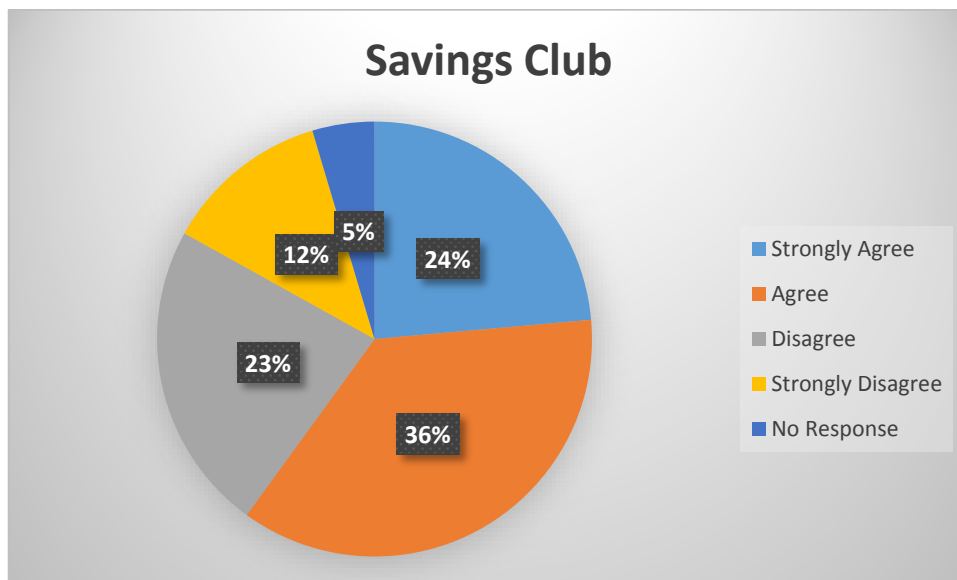
93% of parents/carers strongly agreed or agreed that there should be at least one option of trouser priced at £10 or less, regardless of size.

5. There should be an option for uniform to be delivered free of charge to college



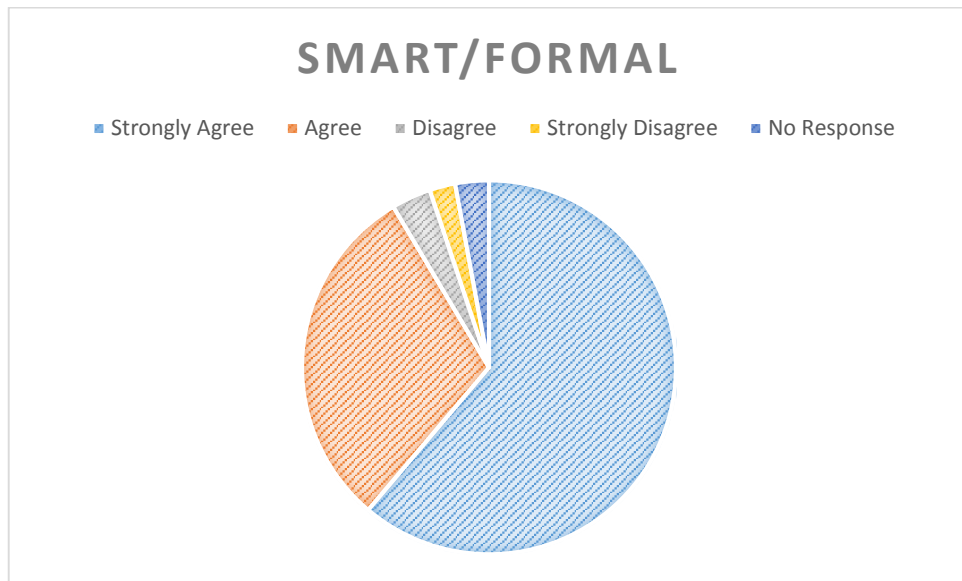
94% of parents/carers strongly agreed or agreed that there should be an option for uniform to be delivered free of charge to the college.

6. I would consider using a savings scheme run by the college to support the purchase of uniform



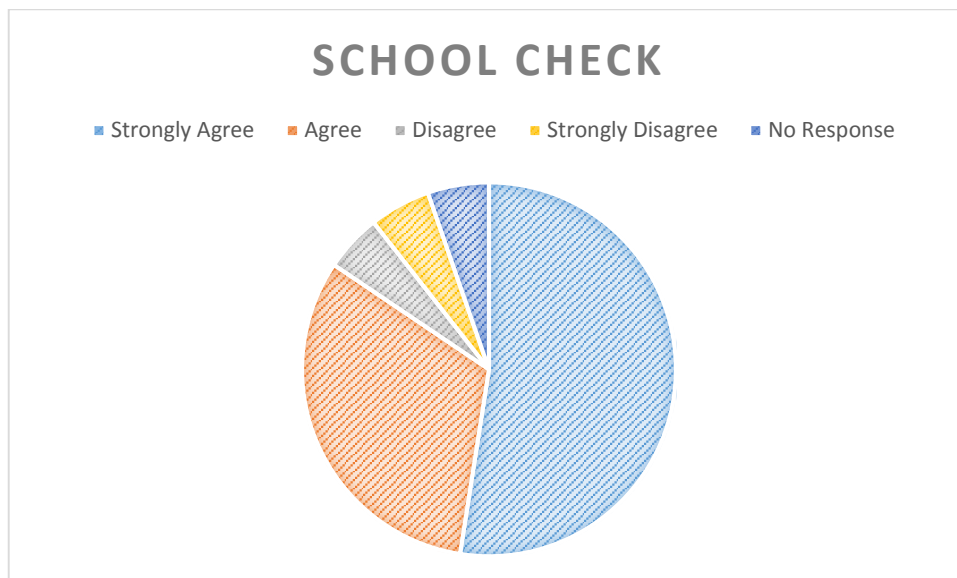
59% of parents/carers strongly agreed or agreed that they would consider using a savings scheme run by the college to support the purchase of uniform.

7. All students should wear appropriate, formal trousers or skirts



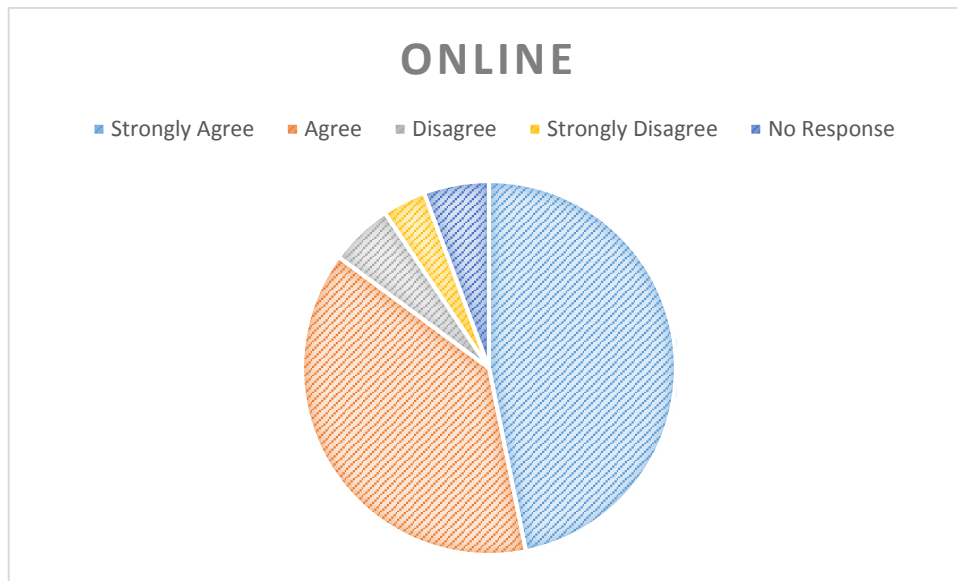
91% of parents/carers strongly agreed or agreed that all students should wear appropriate, formal trousers or skirts.

8. It should be simple for college staff to check that students are in suitable uniform, allowing more time for important work such as improving teaching and learning



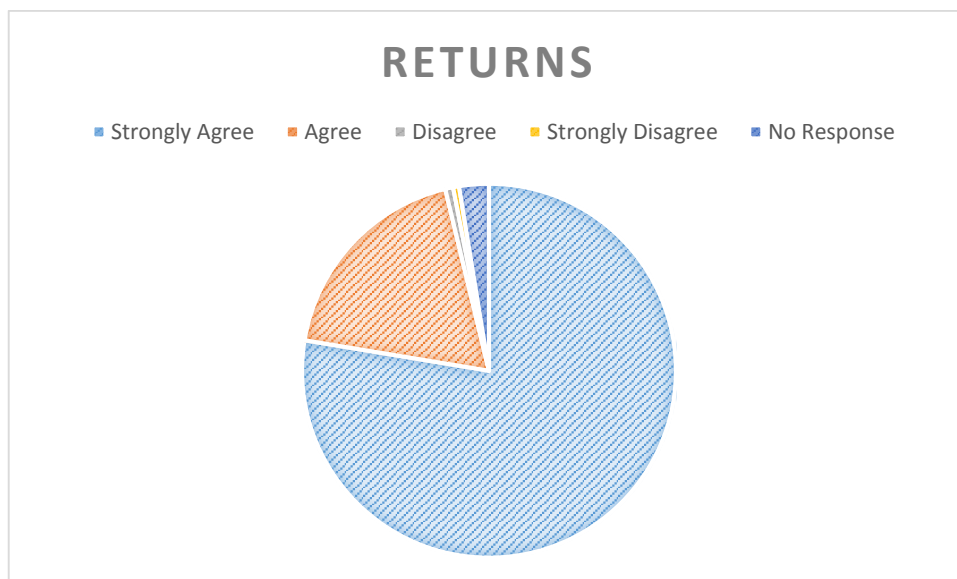
88% of parents/carers strongly agreed or agreed that it should be simple for college staff to check that students are in suitable uniform.

9. It should be possible to buy uniform online



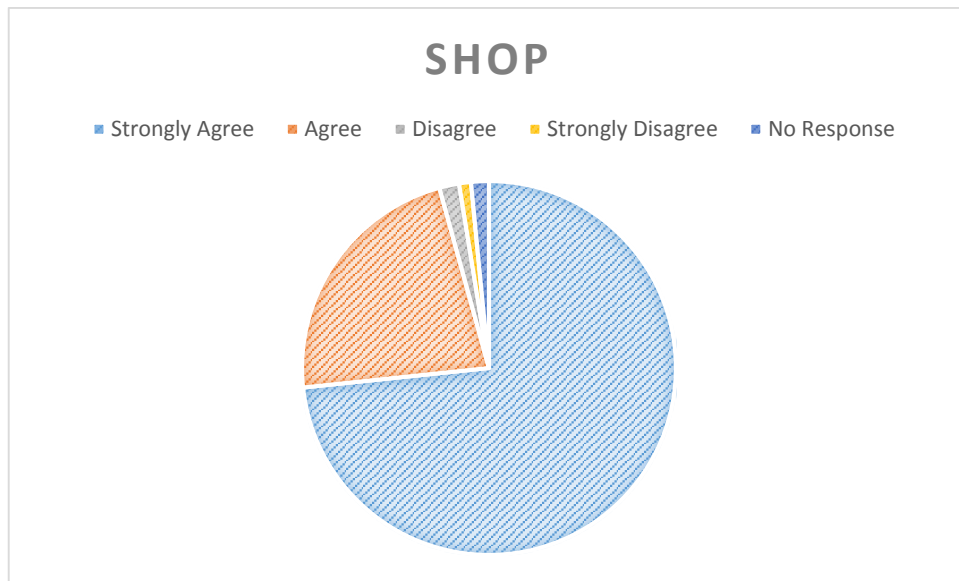
85% of parents/carers strongly agreed or agreed that it should be possible to buy uniform online.

10. It should be possible to return or exchange unsuitable uniform items easily, without additional cost



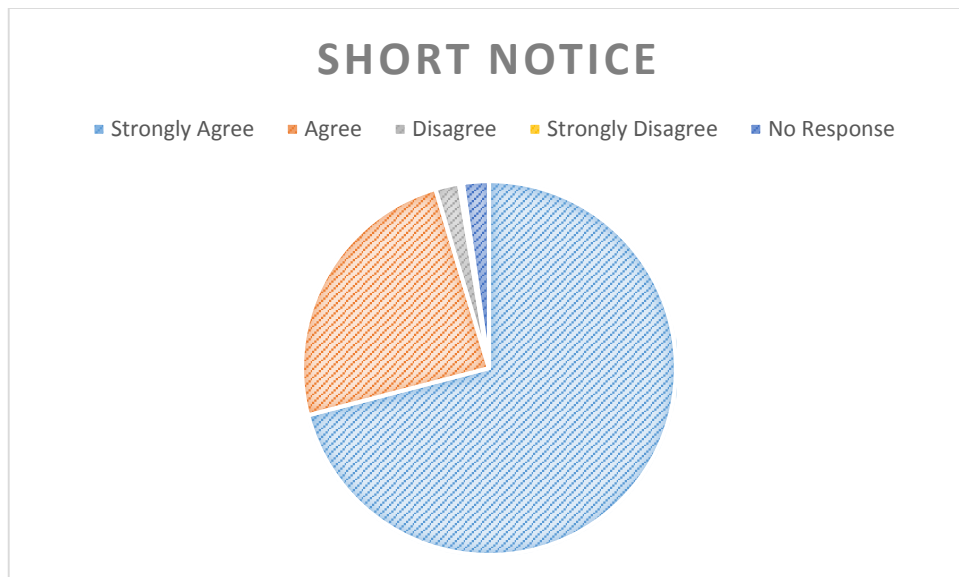
97% of parents/carers strongly agreed or agreed that it should be possible to return or exchange unsuitable uniform items easily, without additional cost.
